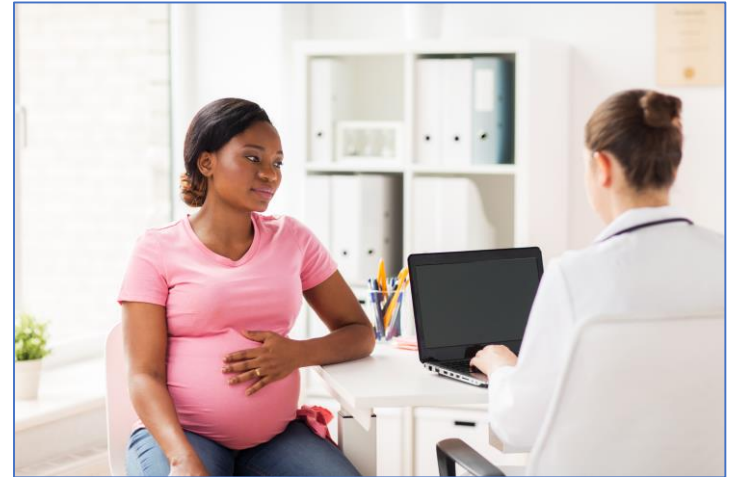


Creating an order for cervical cancer screening

Purpose: Use this job aid to create an ambulatory CPOE order for cervical cancer screening (pap smear).


Audience: Physicians, ACPs and clinical team mates placing orders for cervical cancer screening.

Key Points: Location of orders, details of the orders, finding reference information.



Navigation to Orders Page

1. In the patient's chart, navigate to **Ambulatory Quick Orders** in the menu.

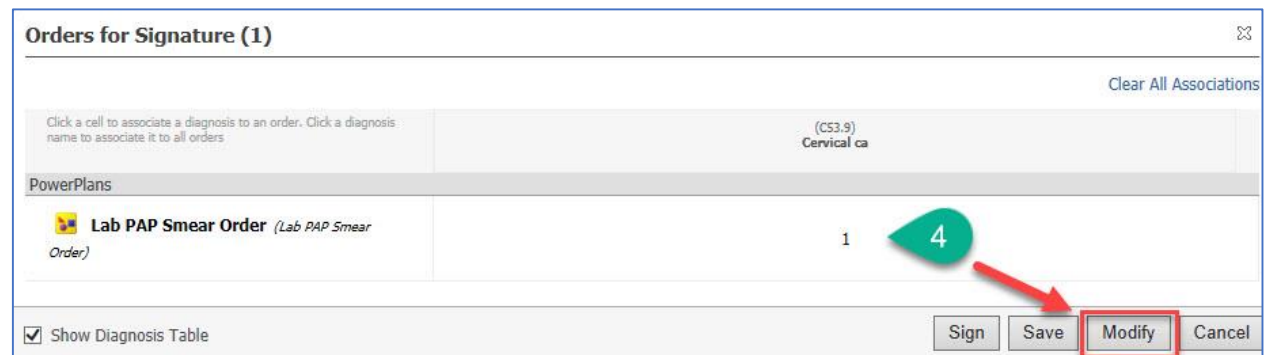
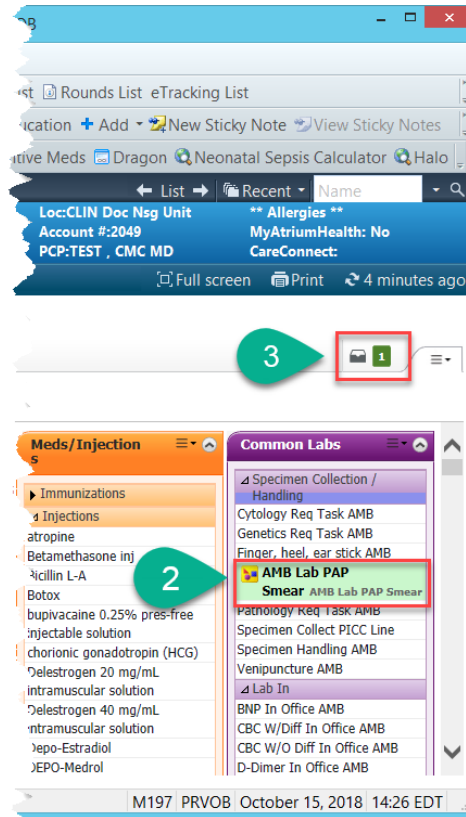

2. Choose the order you want to use for the cancer screening.

3. Click the number in the green box to sign or modify the orders.

4. Associate the order with a diagnosis, then click **Modify** to add details to the order

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5. Right-click the order and click **Modify** to open the **Details** pane.



6. Required details are shown in yellow in the bottom of the window.

7. The **Related Results** panel shows information that is relevant to the order details. This searches the patient's chart to display items useful for decision support.



Sometimes this sidebar is hidden at the bottom of the window.

The related results panel may not show ALL relevant information.

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Always select the patient's diagnosis for the visit if it is one of the options in the **Risk Factors** menu.

Multi-Select means you can select any of the listed risk factors that apply to your patient. Hold down the CTRL key on your keyboard while clicking your mouse to select more than one option.

Currently menstruating means the patient was menstruating on the day she was seen.


